HISTORY

1960 Werner Hagnauer & Lilly Bodmer arrived to Costa Rica from Switzerland to work at Hacienda La Pacifica. They buy the farm with partners; while he worked in the farm as an agronomist, Lilly rescued wild animals.



1985 They sold the farm, and kept 25Ha where the animals where moved.

2003 Hagnauer Foundation was founded to run the Rescue Shelter Las Pumas

2015 Werner passed away

2018 Hagnauer Foundation continues....



MISSION

Rescue, rehabilitate y guarantee the quality of life of the wild animals of Costa Rica, promoting respect and love to animals and educating more of their threats and natural history.

PROGRAMS



WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

- 160 animals of 42 different species, are rescued annually
- Causes of income: orphans, babies, injured, aggression, road hit, electrocutions or illegal tenenance as pets
- 50% of the animals are released to their natural habitat

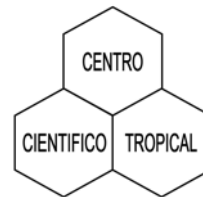
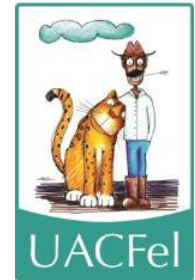
